



County Incentives

The City of Aurora is located in parts of three different counties, namely Adams County, Arapahoe County and Douglas County. Each county offers resources that can aid business expansion and relocation. Please contact Aurora Economic Development Council at 303-340-2101 for further information.

Personal Property Tax Waivers

- Legislation allows cities and counties to negotiate *property tax waivers* of up to 50 percent for four to ten years on taxable personal property. Projects are considered on a case-by-case basis. The Aurora Economic Development Council coordinates all incentive requests.

Federal Job Training Programs

The county employment and training offices administer the following federal workforce training and development programs:

- Federal assistance is primarily available through *Workforce Investment Act (WIA) programs*. Many WIA funds are *tied to training low- and moderate-income persons as well as re-training displaced workers of all skill levels* who are unemployed.
- *The Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)* is a federal income tax credit that encourages employers to hire eight targeted groups of job seekers. WOTC can reduce employer federal tax liability by as much as *\$2,400 per new hire*.
